MİLAS İASOS FISH MARKET MUSEUM

FISH MARKET IN İASOS, A 5 THOUSAND YEAR OLD
FISHING CITY



It was opened as an open-air museum in 1955 after being restored by the Turkish-Italian Cooperation. This complex of buildings in the Kıyıkışlacık district consists of a monumental tomb in the center of a rectangular area with a prostyle floor plan podium and arched porticoes surrounding the area. The museum exhibits stone and terracotta artefacts found during excavations in and around Iasos Ancient City.



Guidi, who visited the city in 1920, thought it might be a fish market (macellum), given the size of the building. Located in the open-air museum, and dated back to 2nd century CE, the grave structure has a square plan (10x7 m), and the remains of the grave are displayed in the central part of the museum.
